These patterns can be f elt by other dragons, who will then know where to find the eggs. This belief is not just limited to egg-laying; dragons also believe that certain locations hold special powers or energies. addition to these beliefs about the natural world, dragons also have a complex system of morality. They believe that actions sh ould be guided by wisdom and compassion rather than power or greed. The te mple was filled with treasures beyond their wildest dreams but as they began to take them out of the temple for personal gain, t hey were confronted by an angry dragon elder. explained that each treasure had its own unique energy pattern which was connected to different parts of nature (waterfirewoo d etc.).
